Texas Longhorn Cattle. After the Civil War devastated the country's economy, Texas had a valuable resource with millions of longhorn cattle roaming wild across the Texas plains.

During the next two decades great herds of these longhorn cattle were rounded up and driven north to the railheads in Kansas. Though only worth about a dollar a head in Texas, a single longhorn could sell for about forty dollars in the northeastern markets. Probably the greatest migration of livestock in the history of the world, over six million longhorns made the three-month trek north, and the profit from those cattle revitalized the Texas economy. 




