

Celebrated on the Third Saturday in May



The first Armed Forces Day was held on May 20, 1950.

World Turtle Day is an annual observance occurring every May 23.

The day was created as a yearly observance to help people celebrate and protect turtles and tortoises and their disappearing habitats around the world as well as to encourage human action to help them survive and thrive.

The turtle shell is a visual match for the days and moons in a lunar year. If you look at a turtle's shell, you will see an outer ring of small scales. These represent the 28 days in a lunar month. You will also see larger scales inside the center of the shell. These large scales represent the 13 moons that occur each lunar year.

Many Native American people look at Turtle's back as a sort of calendar, with its pattern of 13 large scales standing for 13 moons in each year.

Depending on how we measure a lunar month, the moon goes around the earth in approximately 28 days. This means that in one year (365 days), the moon goes around 13 times, giving us 13 lunar months with 28 days each.

And if you examine a turtle's shell, you will find the same pattern of numbers of lunar months in a year and days in a lunar month:
