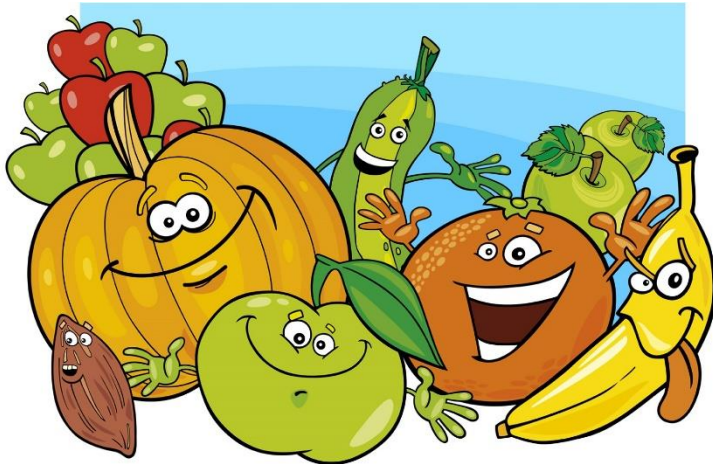

Bond (cont'd)

As of 2021, there have been twenty-four films in the Eon Productions series. The most recent Bond film, Spectre (2015), stars Daniel Craig in his fourth portrayal of Bond; he is the sixth actor to play Bond in the Eon series. There have also been two independent productions of Bond films: Casino Royale (a 1967 spoof starring David Niven) and Never Say Never Again (a 1983 remake of an earlier Eon-produced film, 1965's Thunderball, both starring Connery). In 2015 the series was estimated to be worth \$19.9 billion, making James Bond one of the highest-grossing media franchises of all time.

"No Time to Die" is a 2021 spy film and the 25th in the James Bond series.. It stars Daniel Craig in his fifth and final outing as the fictional British MI6 agent. It is set to be released in the US on **8 October 2021.** (*more on pg 3*)

Disney World continued:

In the first year of opening, the park attracted 10,712,991 visitors. Admission prices in 1971 were \$3.50 for adults, \$2.50 for juniors under age 18, and one dollar for children under twelve.

When the Magic Kingdom opened in 1971, the site employed about 5,500 "cast members". In 2020, Walt Disney World employs more than 77,000 cast members. The largest single-site employer in the United States, Walt Disney World has more than 3,000 job classifications with a total 2019 payroll of over \$3 billion

Resorts

There are thirty-four resorts and hotels on the Walt Disney World property, 28 are owned and operated by Walt Disney Parks, These are classified into four categories—Deluxe, Moderate, Value, and Disney Vacation Club Villas—and are located in one of five resort areas: the Magic Kingdom, Epcot, Wide World of Sports, Animal Kingdom, or Disney Springs resort areas.
